

## **Volunteer Opportunities**

### **Area Team Member**

Our ministry programs are designed to foster relational connections with students. We have opportunities for adults to participate in our programs alongside the students, with the goal of building a relationship with them. This person should be willing to get in and engage students in conversation. We offer some great relational training in how to best do this. Areas of ministry include: skatepark, concerts (Red Room), coffee/snack bar, gymnasium.

### **Administrative Team Member**

We have many weekly tasks and periodic projects that are completed by volunteers. This person should enjoy working on tasks or projects and have good attention to detail. Computer skills a plus but not required. Areas of ministry include: mailings, gen. admin, filing, data entry.

### **Media/Tech Team Member**

Much of our ministry utilizes media, both in print and in video form. We have opportunities for people to utilize their skills and help our ministry connect with the community and our supporters. This person should have a working knowledge in one or more of the ministry areas. Basic training is available. Areas of ministry include: graphic design, mailings, web design & maintenance, photography & editing, videography & editing.

### **Building/Facilities Team Member**

We use our building to its fullest, and there are many opportunities to help us keep it in good working order. We also have special projects or improvements from time to time that we will utilize people for. This person should enjoy working with their hands. Basic construction or speciality skills a plus, but not required. Areas of ministry include: weekly cleaning, kitchen, repair projects, construction/installation projects, We have opportunities for people with plumbing and electrical skills as well.

### **Campus Coach**

We provide Christian students with a adult mentor who meets with them and helps them in their efforts to bring the gospel to their school campus. This person should be willing to meet with a small group of students several times a month for prayer and encouragement. They should have a desire to help students make a difference at their school. Areas of ministry include: All local schools.

### **Mentor**

A component of our internship program is to provide our interns with a mentor from the local community. This person should be a person of faith who is willing to meet several times a month with our intern. This person should be interested in contributing to the intern's personal and spiritual growth during their time here. Commitment length is from 6-12 months.
